Welcome to your special week at camp. Each of the elementary programs is based on our non-competitive philosophy that values individuals just as they are. You'll swim, boat, sing, worship, have campfires, and devote extra time to the following specialty you have selected:

### **Mystery Camp (Events 1130, 4130 and 6130)**

This week is for you if you are interested in getting to the bottom of things and investigating mysteries. Each day, your group will spend time unraveling a mystery (who done it, scavenger hunt, Bible mystery, riddles, etc.) This event will help you develop your problem-solving skills. Please bring an open mind ready for adventure!

### **Fun with Science (Events 2140 and 7140)**

This week is for you if you are interested in learning about what makes things tick. We will look at the science that explains everyday events: What makes the sky blue? What is a rainbow? We will also include many activities enjoyed by all elementaries. This event is designed to be fun, interactive, and informative. We will experiment with basic science concepts.

### **Crafty Campers (Event 3150)**

If construction paper, pipe cleaners, beads, and glue are among your favorite things, this is the unit for you. Campers will complete at least one project a day, and still have time for other camp activities.

### **Soccer Skills Camp (Event 5160)**

All good teams--whether on the playing field, in the theater, in school or at church--get that way because they practice fundamentals, stay focused on their common purpose, and most importantly infuse fun into their experience as a community. This week we will build a team while individually challenging ourselves in soccer fundamentals. Each day you and your group will spend two hours practicing the fundamentals of soccer. While soccer is a competitive sport, this week the competition is based on the goals that each camper sets to achieve. Your goal may be to kick the ball farther than 20 yards or be a better goalie. The choice is always yours.

**Please bring the following items to camp with you:** Cleats, shin guards, comfortable shorts and shirts, water bottle, and sun screen. A soccer ball is a recommended but optional article.
